

CLEANING RECOMMENDATIONS- SERGEANT BLUFF PLANT PRODUCTS

GROUP I - The following products can be cleaned with either the proper dilutions of Strong Proprietary Cleaners according to the Chemical Manufacturer's Recommendations or a cleaning solution of 10 parts water and 1 part Muriatic Acid.

Bronco Classic, Desert Blend, Ponderosa, Russet, Coppertone, Mountain Shadow, and Grand Canyon.

GROUP II - The following products can be cleaned with the proper dilution with "Moderate Strength" cleaners such as Lime Solvent 101 or Sure Clean 600 or equal. Please follow the Chemical Manufacturer's recommended cleaning practices.

Clear Buff, Palomino, Dakota Pink, Toasted Grand Teton, Mission Pink, Coral Pink, Regency Blend, and Sienna.

GROUP III - The following products contain manganese dioxide and should not be cleaned with Muriatic Acid Cleaners (Hydrochloric Acid). Special Proprietary Cleaners such as Vanatrol in proper dilution are recommended in accordance with the Chemical Manufacturer's recommended cleaning practices.

Black Hills, Ebonite, Doeskin, Toasted Fine Art, Fine Art, Vintage Brown, Dunes Gray, Sterling Gray, Beige Gray, Morning Mist, Charcoal Gray, Gunsmoke, Silverstone Gray, Loess Hills, Marblestone Gray, White Plains, Chateau Gray, Badlands, Elk Creek, Glacier Gray, Winter Park, Butternut, Chestnut, Gas Burn Matts, Monterey Smooth Ironspot, Sedona Smooth Ironspot, Chateau Gray, Castile Gray, Cherry Blossum, Deer Valley, Kodiak, Santa Fe, and Mojave.

For brick blends please contact the selling agent.

Brick using colored mortar should follow Group III recommendations.
